MR COWERN'S REPORT.

From the evidence taken through the bankrupt, the Trustee reports thus: "Upon Mr North obtaining a judgment for £1241, which the debtor had not counted he owed, bankruptcy was inevitable." Then again he says the transfer of the property to the sons appeared a fair and honorable course, for the reason that North's claim, "it is sworn," was never considered owing.

Now in addition to the witnesses who swore to the contrary on the trial, I have other impartial witnesses to whom the bankrupt and his son acknowledged their liability as regards my claim; besides other evidence to confirm it.
