LC 11 Aug 1921

Mr **K. Shaw**, who has purchased the old-established hardware business of Mr Sims in Oxford Street, has an announcement in another column concerning his great opening sale, which starts on Friday. It is Mr Shaw's intention to quit the present stocks at cost price to make room for new goods arriving.

LDC 15 Feb 1926

Mr **K. Shaw** has taken a lease of the premises just vacated by Mr J. W. Rimmer, but before moving over will hold a genuine sale of crockery and hardware. The window gives an indication of prices.

LDC 19 Mar 1926

Mr **K. Shaw**, Levin's Ironmonger, has now moved into larger premises on the opposite side of the street. Extensive alterations have been carried out on the frontage which gives the shop a very up-to-date aspect. The show window space has been considerably increased and a very fine vestibule allowed at the entrance. The black backing in the windows considerably enhances the display effect of the various lines of household ironmongery and crockery. The interior is large, well lighted and airy. On the right extending right down the shop is the stock of ironmongery well laid out to effect quick and efficient service while the left is devoted to crockery, displayed in a most attractive manner.

Practically the whole of Mr Shaw's stock of crockery is imported direct from the British manufacturer, thus giving greater value as well as exclusive design in many of the lines. The public are cordially invited to walk through and inspect the stock at any time without any obligation to buy.

Shaw's was a busy shop when adjacent to the Post Office, but with the extra scope for larger displays a considerable increase is expected and the new premises are well equipped to allow Mr Shaw to handle this thoroughly.

wall there. On the northern side the two-storeyed building occupied by Mr Billens and the Oxford Tea Rooms (first floor) and Messrs **K. Shaw** and Hughes were in danger at one time, huge volumes of flame leaping over the brick wall and threatening an entry through the sky-lights of the tea-rooms. Some of the contents of the upper storey were salvaged but as events turned out this was not necessary. The intensity of the fire is indicated by the fact that the iron tie rods and anchors on the outside of the brick wall were melted by the heat.

NEW SHOWROOM AT **K. SHAW'S**
